

Facemask Project 2020 – Facemask Patter With Pocket

Supplies:

- A piece of fabric: 15" x 7 1/2"
- Two 40" Strips of Bias Tape
or
Two strips each 1.5 x WOF

Instructions:



- Take fabric and zig-zag around the entire rectangle.



- Fold the fabric (right-side on right-side) horizontally in half (e.g. "Flipping")
- Mark, on the top, 1 1/2" to the center from each side as shown above.
- Sew a 1/2"-seam from each pin all the way to the outside edge (1 1/2").
- Press the seam open.

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- Top-stitch along the seam and, also, along the fold of the opening.

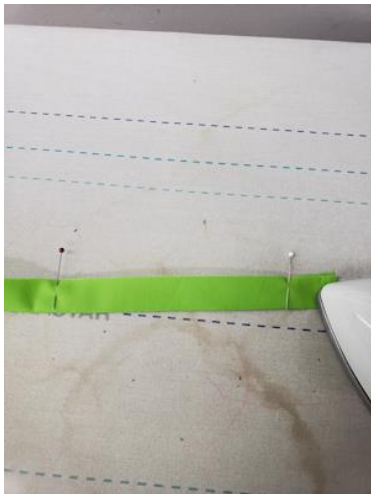


- Turn the fabric inside-out (the fabric right-side will be on the outside).
- Fold the fabric so that the opening is $\frac{1}{2}$ " below the top; creating a pocket for the filter.
- Pin and baste along the sides.



- With right-side facing up, create three pleats.
- Pin the pleats down and baste.
(The finished width is about 3")

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- Take your 1 ½” fabric strips and press them in-half.
- Open one of your strips up and fold each side towards the center. Press!
- Do the same, for the second strip.
- Wrap a strip on each side of the mask and top-stitch the entire length of each strip.
