

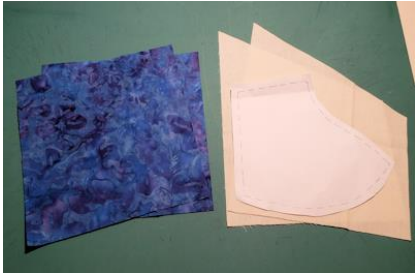
## Facemask Project 2020 – Simple Facemask Pattern

### Supplies:

- I used fabrics leftover from projects : 6 " x 6 ½"  
Two pieces for the outside and two pieces for the lining.
- Two pieces of elastic each of about 10" long
- Pattern (see the last page of this document).  
Don't forget to Print 100% size.

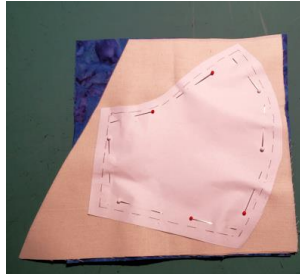


### Instructions:



- Take two pieces each (of the Outside and Lining fabrics)

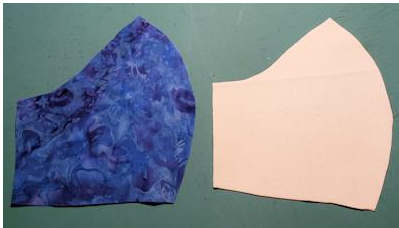
Place them Right-Side on Right-Side.



- Stack the four pieces on top of each other and pin the pattern down onto the fabric.



- Cut the fabric/pattern stack around the pattern.



- Sew the Outside pair and Lining pairs together along the curved outside (with a ¼"seam).



- Pinch each seam.

## Facemask Project 2020 – Simple Facemask Pattern



- Take the two pieces (Right-Side on Right-Side) and line up the Center seam.



- Pin the two pieces together (along the raw edges).



- Sew the two pieces together (with a ¼" seam).

Remember to leave a small opening.



- Trim the corners and then turn the mask inside out.



- Pin the edge of the mask (front side, shown above).



(Back side)



- Top-Stitch along the edge.



- Fold each side about ½" and tuck an elastic band under each fold.

Top-Stitch along each fold.
